

**INDEMNITY AGREEMENT: REGIONAL INLET INVASIVE PLANT PROGRAM  
INVASIVE SPECIES CONTROL WORK COMMERCIAL LAWN APPLICATION CONTRACT**

Owner, in consideration of receiving assistance from Hamilton County Soil & Water Conservation District  
(HCSWCD) in controlling invasive species on the Property, hereby agrees as follows:

Owner agrees to the physical, chemical or biological removal of invasive species from the Property by the HCSWCD  
(including employees, contractors, volunteers), and releases from liability and agrees to hold harmless the HCSWCD  
(including employees, contractors and volunteers) from and against any and all claims arising from these invasive  
species control activities on the Property, whether such activities involve the physical removal of invasive species  
from the Property, the use of chemical or biologic control activities, or any other activity that the Owner and  
HCSWCD mutually choose to employ on the Property.

Owner recognizes that there may be risks associated with all forms of invasive species control activities, and  
acknowledges that the HCSWCD has made no representations, express or implied, about any such risks.

Invasive plant control measures using herbicides to treat Japanese Knotweed (*Polygonum cuspidatum*) will include  
three applications of glyphosate: Accord or Rodeo concentrate (EPA Reg. No. 62719-324), Accord XRT II (EPA  
62719-556) by pesticide applicators selected by the HCSWCD: **Ryan Burkum**, NYS Certified Commercial Pesticide  
applicator #C6863506; 700 County Road 48 Norwood, NY 13668 518-637-1336; NYSDEC Pesticide Business  
Registration #15056. The approximate date of application is Aug 15 to Sept 7, 2018. (Alternate dates Aug 1-14 or  
Sept 8-30). If needed, there may be additional pesticide applications during those dates 2019 to 2023. The  
property owner or owner's agent may request the specific date or dates of the application(s) to be provided and, if  
so requested, the pesticide applicator or business must inform the owner of the specific dates and include that  
date or dates in the contract. There will be no charge to the owner, with costs covered by donations from owners  
and others, grants, and the town/county. There is no guarantee that the control work will be performed. Included  
with this contract is a list of the pesticides to be applied and any label warnings that are pertinent to the protection  
of humans, animals or the environment.
